LETTER OF CONDITIONAL RECOGNITION

Sub : **Regarding grant of conditional recognition for starting teacher education Courses.**

In terms of Sections 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the institutions mentioned in para 3 below had submitted applications to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting teacher training programmes mentioned against their names.

2. The application submitted by the institutions mentioned in the table below seeking recognition from the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for conducting teacher training programme as mentioned against their names in column 3 were scrutinized by the NRC in its 106th meeting held on 11-12 August, 2006 at NCTE Headquarters, New Delhi.

3. On the basis of the scrutiny of the documents submitted by the institution, input received from the Visiting Team Report, the NRC at its 106th meeting held on 11th & 12th August, 2006 at NCTE Hqrs, noted the following compliance required to be made by the following institutions before the commencement of the academic session 2006-2007 :-

The Committee observed that the colleges at S.No. 01 to 07 as contained in part I of the table have not appointed faculty in the institution in accordance with the provisions of NCTE Regulations particularly associating a nominee of the affiliated body of the Selection Committee. The grant of recognition to such institution is subject to production of documentary evidence to the effect that they have appointed staff in compliance with the aforesaid observation of the Committee.

In view of the above, the committee decided to issue a conditional recognition to the above institutions and also advised to remove the deficiencies shown against their names and comply within 21 days from the date of issue of this letter.

3. The institutions shall undertake to appointment the staff by a duly constituted selection committee and ensure selection of candidates possessing qualifications as prescribed under rules. However, in case duly qualified staff are not available, for relaxation in terms of the requirement relating to passing of NET / SLET / Ph.D etc. the institution may refer to the NCTE Regulations dated 21.07.2006 (copy enclosed) and comply accordingly.

Therefore, the institutions are hereby issued a conditional recognition for further necessary action as per the NCTE Rules and Regulations for the commencement of the session 2006-2007.
